

## ORDER SETTING UVALDE COUNTY, TEXAS TAX RATE FOR 2009

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Uvalde County Commissioners Court to increase the tax levy in order to provide funds with which to meet the budget requirements of the County and to pay the expenses necessarily incurred in connection with the services provided by the County to UVALDE County residents:

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT:

1. That there is hereby levied and shall be assessed and collected for 2009 an ad valorem tax of 5.7162 per 100 assessed valuation on all taxable property within the county as shown on the final approved 2009 tax rolls.

THIS RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAX REVENUE FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS AND DEBT SERVICE THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE.

2. That this tax rate is adopted in the following components:

General Fund Maintenance/Operating Expense Tax Rate	.4395
Farm Market-Flood Maintenance/Operating Expense Tax Rate	.1267
I & S Rate for 2009 Series Certificates of Obligations	.1500
2009 Total Ad Valorem Tax Rate	\$.7162

- 3. That for comparison purposes, a \$100,000 home (not allowing for exemptions), paid \$566.20 to Uvalde County in 2008. In 2009 the same house, at the same value (not allowing for exemptions), would pay \$716.20 to Uvalde County.
- 4. That the <u>Uvalde County Appraisal District</u> is hereby authorized and directed to prepare 2009 tax statements and transmit same to the owners of taxable property within the County on or before October 1, 2009, or as soon thereafter as possible.
