8. CONSIDER AND ACT UPON PRESENTATION OF 2008 AUDIT BY AUDITOR WAYNE BEYER AND ASSOCIATES:

Uvalde County's financial statements were audited by Wayne R. Beyer, CPA, a licensed certified public accountant. The goal of the independent audit was to provide reasonable

assurance that the financial statements of Uvalde County for the fiscal year ended September 30, 2008 are free of material misstatement. The independent audit involved examining, on a test basis, evidence supporting the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements; assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by management; and evaluating the overall financial statement presentation.

Mr. Beyer concluded, based upon the audit, that there was a reasonable basis for rendering an unqualified opinion that Uvalde County's financial statements for the fiscal year ended September 30, 2008 are fairly presented in conformity with GAAP.
