PUBLIC INFORMATION FOR COLLECTING WATER SAMPLE

- 1. Wipe off any foreign material from inside and outside of the faucet.
- 2. Remove the screen, from inside the faucet if on is present.
- 3. Use alcohol to disinfect around and inside of any interior faucets. If using a portable heat source (example Propane torch) for the dis-infection of exterior facets, use caution not to damage faucets.
- 4. Turn on the cold water side of faucet and allow the water to run for 15 to 20 seconds.
- 5. Collect the water sample with the water running. Be certain to collect 100 ml of water as it is marked on the sample bottle provided.
- 6. Chill or refrigerate the water sample until you return the sample to Uvalde County Health Department at 66 Military Lane at the Uvalde County Fairplex.
- 7. Fill out the Bacteria Analysis form completely. If you are a Public Water System make sure ID# and Chlorine Residual present.
- 8. The Uvalde County Health Department collects water samples twice a month, on the first two Tuesdays of the month. Sample must be collected on the same day of turn in, before 3:00pm.
- 9. There is a \$28.00 fee collected for each sample.

PS: Do not attempt to send water samples to lab on your own without instruction.
