

**A SUMMATION OF THE PROCESS BY WHICH  
A SEPTIC SYSTEM IS OBTAINED  
IN UVALDE COUNTY**

1. Determine if proposed system is to be located in flood plain  
(This can be done by reviewing Federal Emergency Management maps)
  - a. If system is NOT in flood plain, proceed to step 2.
  - b. If system is in flood plain, consult with civil engineer/surveyor to aid in determination of suitability of system.
  - c. Present engineer's findings to County Judge.
  - d. If County Judge approves, permit will be allowed in flood plain  
Proceed to step 2.
2. Contact Uvalde County Sanitarian for information on licensed site evaluator for consultation and design of system.
3. Submit design to the County of Uvalde Department of Health/ Sanitarian for review and approval.
4. Upon approval, a licensed installer may proceed with construction.
5. Immediately prior to covering the system, final inspection by the Health Department is required.
5. Installer will contact County Health Inspector for inspection and the system is completed.
